

# Band & Chorus Menu

In the mood for band and chorus practice ideas?

This is just what you need!

Explore the options below (even try them all).

(Band = blue / Chorus = yellow / Both = green)

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| Play your favorite song from your book 5 times in a row without making mistakes.   | Play or sing a mini concert for your family.  | Make up a new chorus warm up. Try filming it and share it with me so I can learn it too!   | Practice a song from the book in a different place in your house from where you normally practice.              |
| Record a video of yourself playing or singing a song and watch it.   | Look in the back cover of the book and teach yourself 2 new notes.  | Teach someone to play your instrument or sing a song. (Make sure to use new reeds and clean off your mouthpiece!)                              | With permission, look up the President's Own Marine Band on YouTube and find someone playing your instrument!   |
| Make up a new song - melody and lyrics! For inspiration, try writing about one of your favorite things, or a special occasion.     | Find the name of an accomplished musician that plays your instrument (or sings!). Watch a video (or several!) of them performing. | Thoroughly clean your instrument. (If you need help, look at the info paper in your folder, look in Google Classroom or watch a video online.) | Make up different lyrics to one of your favorite songs. Try making it a "parody" (a joke song) about something! |
| See how many seconds you can hold a note for. (Percussionists - count how many times you can play on your drum pad in 30 seconds). | Learn a new song in the book on your own!   | With permission, look up an a cappella group (try Pentatonix!) and listen to a song using ONLY voices! (Listen for beat boxing, too!)          | Play or sing a song you've learned from memory.   |
