



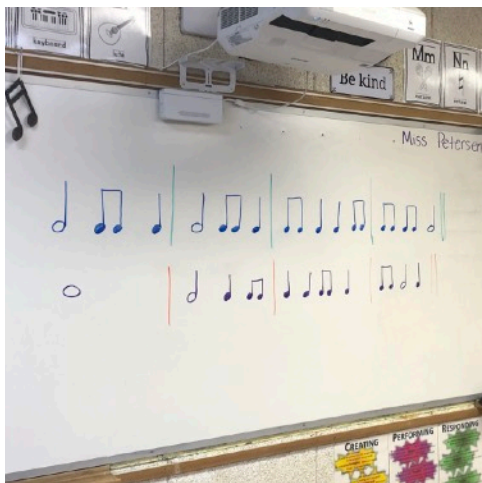
Music Quote of the Month:
