## January in Review

- Pre-K & Kindergarten: We reviewed the musical opposites we have learned so far and did some extra practice with high and low! The kindergarteners also created their own high/low patterns to share in their classes.
- First Grade: We continued our music literacy work, including a new song “Bee Bee Bumble Bee,” and we learned how to write music notes!
- Second Grade: We enjoyed working as a team to play Boomwhacker songs together and we finished the month by learning about dynamics.
- Third Grade: We learned about dynamics in music (how loud or quiet music is) and have started learning about a new type of note and rhythm.
- Fourth Grade: We finished learning about the brass family and, before moving onto the woodwinds, we’ll learn the “cup game” routine and create our own cup patterns and rhythms!
- Fifth Grade: We finished our ukulele unit (although we’ll revisit them again in the spring) and we have started to learn about spirituals.
